



Copyright Policy for Digital Assets

Purpose

This Copyright Policy explains the ownership, permitted uses, licensing, and enforcement rules that apply to digital assets published by **1801Adventures** (the “Content”), including PDFs, maps, stat blocks, videos, audio, images, and other downloadable or streamable materials.

Ownership and Copyright

- **All Content is Copyright:** Unless explicitly stated otherwise, all Content published by 1801Adventures is the exclusive copyright of **1801Adventures** or its licensors.
- **Exception:** Content explicitly posted to the **Tips and Tricks** section may be licensed differently; check the specific item for its licence terms.
- **Moral Rights:** We assert moral rights where applicable and expect users to respect author attribution.

Permitted Uses

- **Personal Use:** Subscribers and purchasers may use Content for **personal, non-commercial** tabletop roleplaying play, preparation, and private distribution to players in their own games.
- **Attribution Required:** When using Content at the table or sharing with players, you must **credit 1801Adventures** (for example: “Content provided by 1801Adventures”).
- **Format Changes:** You may convert Content into formats for personal convenience (print, digital notes) provided attribution remains and no logos or copyright notices are removed.



Prohibited Uses

- **No Commercial Exploitation:** You may **not** sell, license, redistribute, or otherwise commercially exploit Content without a written licence from 1801Adventures.
- **No Public Redistribution:** You may **not** upload, post, or distribute Content to public websites, file-sharing services, marketplaces, or social media in a way that allows third parties to download or reuse the Content.
- **No Removal of Notices:** You must not remove or alter copyright notices, logos, or watermarks embedded in Content.
- **No Derivative Commercial Works:** Creating derivative works for commercial distribution requires prior written permission. Non-commercial fan adaptations should still credit 1801Adventures and must not imply endorsement.

Commercial Licensing

- **Requesting a Licence:** For commercial use, contact **1801adventures@gmail.com** or use the website contact form. Provide a description of intended use, distribution channels, and expected audience.
- **Licence Terms:** Commercial licences are granted in writing and may include fees, attribution requirements, and usage limits. Unauthorised commercial use may result in legal action.

User Generated Content

- **Submission Licence:** By submitting content to 1801Adventures (ideas, fan content, or materials), you grant 1801Adventures a **non-exclusive, perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free licence** to use, reproduce, modify, publish, and distribute the submission in connection with our services. Do not submit third-party copyrighted material without permission.
- **Attribution of Submissions:** We will credit contributors where practicable, but we are not obliged to publish or return submissions.

Infringement and Takedown Procedure

- **Report Infringement:** If you believe your copyright has been infringed by Content on our site or by a third party using our Content, email **1801adventures@gmail.com** with:
 - **Your name and contact details;**
 - **Identification of the copyrighted work** you claim is infringed;
 - **Location of the infringing material** (URL or screenshot);



- **A statement** that you have a good faith belief the use is not authorised;
- **A statement** under penalty of perjury that the information is accurate and you are the copyright owner or authorised to act on their behalf;
- **Your electronic signature.**
- **Response:** We will acknowledge receipt and investigate promptly. If we determine infringement, we will remove or disable access to the material and notify the uploader.
- **Repeat Infringers:** We reserve the right to suspend or terminate accounts of repeat infringers.

Enforcement and Remedies

- **Civil and Criminal Remedies:** Unauthorised use may result in civil claims for damages and injunctive relief and, where applicable, criminal prosecution.
- **No Waiver:** Failure to enforce any provision does not waive our rights.
- **Relation to Terms:** This Policy supplements the 1801Adventures Terms & Conditions and Privacy Policy. Remedies for copyright disputes are without prejudice to other contractual or statutory remedies.
