



Player Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct sets clear expectations for behaviour at all 1801Adventures tabletop sessions. It exists to keep play safe, fun, and respectful for everyone. By joining a game you agree to follow these guidelines.

Expected Behaviour

- **Respect:** Treat all players, the GM, and guests with courtesy. Listen when others speak and avoid interrupting.
- **Inclusivity:** Do not use slurs, derogatory language, or exclusionary jokes. Celebrate diversity of backgrounds, identities, and play styles.
- **Punctuality:** Arrive on time or notify the group in advance if you will be late.
- **Preparedness:** Bring character sheets, dice, and any agreed materials. Be ready to engage and contribute.

Safety and Consent

Safety is of the utmost importance within 1801Adventures games. To ensure the best possible experience for everyone, we use multiple systems and clear procedures. By joining a game you agree to follow these safety practices.

Breaks

- Regular break: Sessions include a short 10–15 minute break approximately halfway through each session. Use this time to rest, check in, or step away if you need.

X / N / O Digital Cards

We use a simple, private signalling system to manage boundaries during play. Use these via direct message on Discord or whisper in Foundry—no explanation required.

- X (Stop): Send X if the narrative crosses a personal boundary or becomes triggering. The GM will stop the line of roleplay immediately and retcon to a safe topic.
- N (Tread Carefully): Send N if you think a scene may become uncomfortable but has not crossed your line. This notifies the GM to continue with caution.
- O (Check-in): The GM may send O after an intense moment (character death, emotional scene) to check in: “Are you okay?” Respond honestly; no justification required.



Session Zero

- **Boundaries and expectations:** We hold a Session 0 to discuss character backgrounds, how characters arrive at the carnival, and any hard boundaries to avoid.
- **Rules and tools:** Session 0 also covers server and game rules, safety tools, and how to schedule the monthly one-to-one call.

Safety Tools and Enforcement in Discord

- **Warnings and timeouts:** If behaviour is deemed out of line, the GM will issue a written warning. Continued issues may result in a timeout area with restricted access while we discuss the behaviour and seek resolution.
- **Removal:** If no resolution is reached, the GM reserves the right to remove a player from games and the Discord server for offensive, discriminatory, or risky behaviour. No refund will be given for the session in question in such cases.
- **Confidentiality:** Reports and discussions about safety incidents will be handled confidentially and respectfully.

Reporting and Support

- **How to report:** If you experience or witness unacceptable behaviour, report it privately to the GM or organiser via DM or email (1801adventures@gmail.com). Reports will be taken seriously and investigated.
- **Response:** We aim to respond promptly and fairly; urgent safety concerns may result in immediate action.

Game Integrity and Practical Rules

- **No Cheating:** Do not alter dice rolls, hide information, or manipulate game systems dishonestly. If using digital tools, be transparent about macros or automation.
- **Respect Table Time:** Keep side conversations minimal and relevant. Use breaks for extended chat.
- **Recording and Streaming:** Do not record, stream, or share images of the session or players without **explicit consent** from everyone present.
- **Minors:** If minors are present, follow any additional parental rules and avoid adult themes unless parents have given informed consent.



Reporting and Enforcement

- **Report Concerns:** If you experience or witness unacceptable behaviour, report it to the GM or organiser promptly via the agreed channel (private message or email). Reports will be treated seriously and confidentially.
- **Consequences:** Violations may result in a warning, temporary suspension, or permanent removal from games depending on severity. Immediate removal may occur for harassment, threats, or breaches of physical safety.
- **Appeals:** If you disagree with a decision, you may submit an appeal to the organiser; appeals will be reviewed and responded to within a reasonable timeframe.

Final Notes and Contact

- **Community Responsibility:** Everyone helps maintain a welcoming table. If you see something, say something—kindly and privately when possible.
- **Contact:** For policy questions or to report issues outside a session, contact the organiser at **1801adventures@gmail.com**.
- **Review:** This Code will be reviewed periodically and updated as needed; the current version date will be posted where the policy is published.
